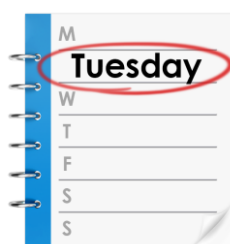


Governing Body Meeting 27th November 2018 Easy Read Agenda

College Avenue, Wigan.



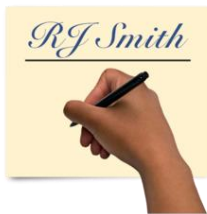
Anyone can come to the meeting

Dr Dalton will tell people what has happened since July.

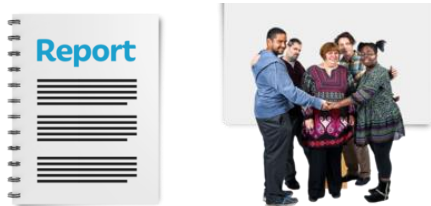
Caroline Kurzeja, the top manager, will tell people what she has done since July.

There is a report on special types of infections.



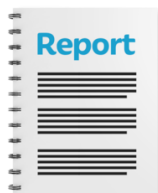
There is a report on how doctors are giving patients less antibiotics.



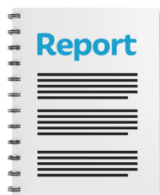
The meeting is asked to decide whether Manchester CCG can make decisions for us on some types of research.

There is a report on the biggest risks to us.

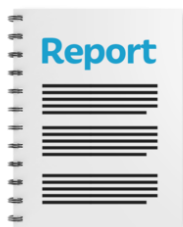


There are notes (minutes) on what happened at the Greater Manchester Health and Care Board.
